

Nomadic poet & performance artist A K Mimi Allin is walking 17,000 miles cross-country, making a path that spells I-o-v-e in cursive letters across the USA. The work begins this April in New Mexico, heads north to Montana, west to Washington, then loops down to California. The following year she will walk the "O," then the "V," finishing in fall of 2027 in Maine (following the red line on the map above). WALKING LOVE is about facing our fears & the darker aspects of what it means to be an American. In solidarity with the refugees in Gaza, the artist will undertake segments of this walk with nothing—no money, no pack, no sleeping bag.
